1. The tenderers are advised in their own interest to carefully read the tender documents and understand their purport unless the tenderer specifically states to the contrary in respect of any particular clause, it shall be presumed that he accepts all the terms and conditions as have been laid down in the tender document.

2. **Tenderers who are interested to supply 50% of the tendered qty of any item are eligible for participation in the tender .** But it should be indicated clearly in the Technical Part of the Bid . If not indicated than tender will be treated for entire tendered qty .

3. **Tender must be submitted in the tender form provided in part “B” of the tender document at Section-III.** The tenderer may attach additional sheets to the tender form wherever detailed description is necessary .**Only those party should tender who accepts all the terms & conditions because conditional tender may be treated as void.**

4. **Erasure or alteration in the bid document should be avoided.** Modification, erasure or alteration, if any, should bear the signature of the person signing the bid along with stamp of the tenderer. THE ENVELOPE CONTAINING THE “TECHNICAL & COMMERCIAL BIDS” AND “PRICE BID” shall also be super scribed thereon “Technical & commercial Bids” and “Price Bids” as the case may be. The tenders not complying with the manner prescribed herein are liable for rejection straight away.**

TECHNICAL & COMMERCIAL BIDS Envelope should contain documents namely Earnest money, a copy current & previous year Income-tax return & PAN No, Sale-tax Vat/TIN/No. with supporting documentary proof, other information as per Section-III Annex ure-B along with supporting document & samples , strictly as per the guide line given in the tender document etc .

All supporting documentary proof may be/should be furnished along with the tender, as per Annexure “B” of section III of part “B” enclosed with the tender document in the envelope of technical & Commercial bid.

25. The tenderer should be enclosed a copy of **current & previous year income tax return** duly acknowledge by Income-tax Department in the envelope containing technical bid.

(Tender Form “ Section I duly signed to be submitted to NSC along with the envelopes marked “Technical & Commercial Bid ”)

SECTION - II

GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF THE CONTRACT

1. **Transfer and subletting:** The supplier shall not sublet, transfer, assign or otherwise part with the contract to any person, firm or Company directly or indirectly or any part thereof without the previous written permission of the Corporation.

2. **Indemnity:** The supplier shall at all times indemnify the Corporation against all claims which may be made in respect of the said items for infringement of any right protected by patent, registration of design or trade mark provided always that in the event of any claim in respect of an alleged breach of a patent registered design or trade mark being made against the Corporation, the Corporation shall notify to the supplier of the same and the supplier shall be bound, but at his own expenses, to conduct negotiations for settlement of prosecute any litigation that may arise there from. In the event of the Corporation becoming liable to any amount on any aforesaid account the supplier shall make good the amount so payable and the expenses incurred on that behalf.

3. **Security deposit:** The supplier shall **within 15 days from the date of issue of purchase order furnish security deposit along with agreement on non-judicial stamp paper** with the Corporation to the extent of 10% of the contract price towards security for the due fulfillment of the conditions of the contract. The security deposit shall be furnished in the following manner.

A) By means of a Demand Draft on any Scheduled Bank payable in New Delhi/Delhi in favour of National Seeds Corporation Ltd., Bank Draft shall be submitted to Purchase Section in writing.

OR

B) By means of Bank guarantee as per prescribed proforma, enclosed under Section-IV of Part-B of the tender document, issued by any Scheduled Bank at Delhi/New Delhi Branch only.

C) In case of non submission of Security Deposit , **the same will be deducted from first 90% payment without taking consent from supplier and later on Bank guarantee will not be acceptable .**

5. **Delivery:** The supplier shall **complete the supply at sites within 60 days from the date on placing purchase order** in phased manner, i.e. 50% of the quantity is to be delivered within 30 days from the date of placing order and balance 50% in next 30 days.

No extension of delivery period shall be allowed to supplier. However, the goods may be dispatched early also for which no extra benefit or relaxation in payment terms shall be allowed to the suppliers. The date of receipt of goods as specified in the prescribed receipt i.e. G R note issued by the consignee shall be final for the purpose of calculating delivery period.

6. Inspection and testing of samples:

A) Cloth bag , Label , HDPE woven non-laminated sack bags, and other Packing material :
The supplier at the appropriate point of time i.e. Minimum 10 days in advance, during the process of manufacturing goods, shall intimate the pre-delivery inspection schedule to the Corporation to depute representative for drawing up random samples of finished goods bearing complete printed as per requirement of the Corporation. These samples will be duly authenticated by NSC representative and representative of manufacturers/suppliers with date.

Post delivery samples drawn at consignee site, shall be sent for testing to the laboratory by the Corporation for the purpose of releasing final 10% payment.

Post Delivery samples will be preserves for six months period from the date on receipt of Test Report from Testing Lab , later on . it will be sent to CS&SD , NSC New Delhi for further use .

B) In case of cloth bags , Label, Jute bags , HDPE non-laminated woven bags , minimum 75000 nos. or at least 33.3% of the ordered quantity whichever is maximum shall be offered/inspected in one lot in general otherwise in case of urgency of material or in the interest of NSC, smaller quantity may also be inspected.

D) In case of DW Jute Tarpaulin bags/B. Twill gunny bags/Flour bags/DW Jute Hessain bags:-

The supplier at the appropriate point of time i.e. Minimum 10 days in advance, during the process of manufacturing goods, shall intimate the pre delivery inspection schedule to the Corporation to depute representative for drawing up samples of finished goods bearing complete printed as per requirement of the Corporation. Inspection committee of the Corporation draw the sample from 100% quantity offered by the supplier based on the guide line given in BIS standards or approved by the Corporation. The inspection team shall put identity on each and every bales of total quantity offered for inspection by the supplier. These samples will be duly authenticated by NSC representative and representative of manufacturers /suppliers with date. The samples drawn at supplier site shall be sent for testing to the laboratory by the Corporation for the purpose of verifying quality of bags. **Bags will be cleared for dispatches only when bags will be found meeting the specification in respect of quality, design, art work, contents and colour scheme etc. which specified by the NSC.** Bags are to be dispatched to all locations in the presence of the Inspection Committee or as per the guide line of the Corporation time to time. **The time requires for testing of samples will be excluded from the delivery period for supply of bag (from the date on sample drawn to date on issue the clearance for dispatch of bags to supplier).** In case bags will not found up to the standard then another lot of bags is to be offered for inspection and testing time of previous lot will not be considered in the delivery period as well as no extra time will be granted .

Post Delivery samples will be preserves for six months period from the date on receipt of Test Report from Testing Lab , later on . it will be sent to CS&SD , NSC New Delhi for further use .

E) Chemicals: (Treatment material etc.) Random samples will be drawn jointly by the Corporation's representative and the representative of the supplier of formulation ordered prior to their final packing at the manufacturer/ suppliers place and duly marked and authenticated by the Corporation's representative drawing the samples and the representative of the supplier/manufacturer. The containers shall also be sealed, marked and identified in the presence of Corporation's representative. Containers without sealed, marked and identified by inspecting team shall not be accepted by the consignee. Out of the samples so drawn, one or more samples will be sent for testing in the laboratory **and material shall be accepted for dispatch only if the material/ meets the required standards in testing.** In case the supplier wants to get the material tested on urgent basis, the difference of testing charges for testing on urgent basis and that in normal charges shall be borne by the suppliers. The expiry date should clearly be super scribed on the container. Documentary proof/undertaking in respect of period of validity should be submitted along with the bill.

7. The expenditure incurred by NSC's nominee such as TA & DA shall be borne by the Corporation. However, the suppliers shall provide its cost of material, equipment, tools , labour and other facility for carrying out inspection/drawing up of samples, for which the 10 days notice to the Corporation/purchaser so that the supplier is in a position to give inspection/drawing up of the samples. The Corporation/purchaser or his authorised nominee may carry out inspections at the supplier's works.

In case the suppliers give a notice and fails to offer the items/stores for inspection/drawing up to the samples on the dates fixed for this purpose, the expenditure incurred on TA/DA of the Corporation's nominee shall have to be borne by the supplier and such failure will not entitle the supplier to ask for any extension for delivery time.

8. Changes in specifications:

A) The Corporation Should require any changes in specifications, the supplier shall use his best endeavor to comply with the Corporation's wishes subject to fair adjustment of prices and delivery schedule where appropriate.

“In case the goods are not supplied according to the specifications and it is decided to retain the inferior goods at the discretion of the Corporation, the supplier will be entitled to receive the payments at the rates fixed by the Corporation after taking into consideration and unsatisfactory quality of the material supplied and not rates mentioned in the purchase order.”

B) If at any time during the terms of this contract the plan of the Corporation changes for any reason beyond the control of the Corporation, the Corporation shall have the right to terminate or alter this contract by sending a notice of such intention to the supplier by hand through a responsible officer. The supplier shall allow such officer to prepare an inventory of such material as

is complete and ready for dispatch. Such officer shall also prepare an inventory of the raw materials which the supplier has already arranged for using in manufacturing the items to be supplied. The Corporation shall accept delivery of the material that are complete and ready for dispatch and may award compensation to the supplier for the raw material already procured or may in its option allow the suppliers to utilize the raw materials and make it ready for dispatch within such period as may be reasonable.

9. **Marking:**

The supplier shall comply with the requirements of Indian acts relating to merchandise and rules made there-under for marking of all the goods supplied.

10. **Packing:**

The supplier shall pack the items/stores sufficiently and properly to ensure its safe delivery without any loss or injury up to destination.

11. **Where sales tax is claimed** and provided as payable in the supply orders. Payments of the same will not be made unless the following certificate is given along with the bill.

12. **Warranty:**

A) The supplier shall warrant the goods to be supplied under this contract shall be free from all defects and faults in material, workmanship and manufacturing and shall be of the highest grade and consistent with the established and generally accepted standards for materials of the type of items/stores ordered and in full conformity with the contract specifications and samples.

B) The supplier shall if required, replace the goods or such portion thereof as is rejected by the Corporation free of cost at the ultimate destination or at any other place or at the option of the Corporation, the supplier shall pay to the Corporation the value thereof at the contract prices and such other expenditure and damage as may arise by reason of the breach of the conditions herein specified.

C) All replacements that the Corporation/Purchaser shall all upon the supplier to deliver or perform under this warranty shall be delivered or performed by the supplier within two months (promptly and satisfactorily). If the supplier desired to take over the defective items/stores it shall be done within one month from the date of replacement. Thereafter, purchaser shall not be responsible to keep the defective items/stores.

13. **Liquidated damages:**

It is emphasized by the Corporation & understood by the supplier that the **period of delivery, stipulated in the contract is the essence of the contract.** It is **admitted by the supplier**

that any delay in the delivery will cause damages to the Corporation. To obviate any dispute as to the amount of damages that are likely to be suffered by the Corporation, the supplier hereby agrees that the Corporation/purchaser shall suffer damages **at the rate of 2% for each week** or part thereof by which delivery is delayed subject to **maximum of 15%** and it shall be deemed to the actual damage suffered by the Corporation. The supplier undertakes that if it fails to have the items/stores ready for delivery by the time specified in the order for supplies, the supplier shall become liable to pay damages at the above rate and shall continue to incur liability to pay damages as the delay increases. **The Corporation may withhold any payment due to the supplier until the whole of the items/stores have been fully supplied and delivered and may deduct or recover from the supplier liquidated damages as stipulated above.** This clause is without prejudice to the right of the Corporation to make risk purchase under next clause and the liability under that clause shall be in addition to liquidated damages.

14. Default & Risk purchase:

A) Should the supplier fail to have the stores ready for delivery as aforesaid, or should the supplier in any manner or otherwise fail to perform the contract or should it fail to complete the supply in time according to the specifications or should it have winding up order made against it or make or enter into any arrangements or composition with its creditor or suspend payments (or being a company should enter into liquidation either compulsory or voluntary) the Corporation shall have power under the hand of MD/ CMD to declare the contract at the end at the risk and cost of the supplier in every way. In such case supplier shall be liable for any liquidated damages for delay as above provided and for any expenses, losses or damages which the Corporation/purchaser may be put incur or sustain by reason of, or in connection with supplier's default.

B) The cancellation of the contract may be either for whole or part of the contract at Corporation's option. In the event of any dispute or difference relating to the interpretation and application of the provisions of the contracts, such dispute or difference shall be referred by either party to the arbitration of one of the arbitrator in the Department of Public Enterprises to be nominated by the Secretary to the Govt. Of India, In charge of the Bureau of Public Enterprises. The arbitration Act 1940 shall not be applicable to the arbitration under this clause. The award of the Arbitrator shall be binding upon the parties to the dispute, provided however, any party aggrieved by such award may making a further reference for setting aside or revision of the award to the Law Secretary, Department of Legal and Affairs, Ministry of Law and Justice, Govt. Of India. Upon such reference, the dispute shall be decided by the Law Secretary or the Special Secretary/Additional Secretary when so authorised by the Law Secretary whose decision shall bind the parties finally and conclusively. The parties to the disputes will share equally the cost of arbitration as intimated by the Arbitrator.

18. Corrupt Gifts & Payments of Commission:

Any bribe, commission, gift or advantages given promised or offered by or on behalf of the supplier his agents or representative or agent of the Corporation/or any person on his behalf in relation to the execution of this or any other contract with the Corporation shall in addition to the criminal liability under the Law enforce, subject the supplier to cancellation of this and other

contracts with the Corporation and also to payment to any less resulting from any such cancellation to the extent as is provided in case of cancellation under “DEFAULT AND RISK PURCHASE’ and the Corporation shall be entitled to deduct the amount so payable from any money otherwise due to the supplier under this or any other contract or may recover the same by appropriate proceedings.

SETTLEMENT OF DISPUTES

All disputes or differences in relation to the tender, the contract or the interpretation of any of their terms or implementation there-of or arising out of or concerned directly or indirectly with the contract shall be referred to the arbitration or a single arbitrator to be appointed by the Managing Director of the Corporation and in the absence of MD, the highest Executive Officer of the Corporation shall make such appointment. The arbitrator shall have powers to enlarge time for making & publishing the award with the consent of the parties. The parties will have no objection to the appointment of the arbitrator on the ground that such arbitrator had dealt with the matter of any earlier stage. If the claims involved in a dispute are of more than Rs.1/- lakh the arbitrator shall make a speaking award.

In case the supplier is a Public Sector Undertaking, the above clause shall not be applicable and in that event the following clause shall apply. In the event of any dispute or difference relating to the interpretation and application of the provisions of the contracts, such dispute or difference

shall be referred by either party to the arbitration of one of the arbitrator in the Department of Public Enterprises to be nominated by the Secretary to the Govt. of India, Incharge of the Bureau of Public Enterprises.
