SECTION-I

INSTRUCTIONS TO THE TENDERES / BIDDER - ONLINE MODE

DEFINITIONS: C1 India Private Limited: Service provider to provide the e-Tendering Software.

NSCL e-Procurement Portal: An e-tendering portal of National Seeds Corporation Limited (“NSCL”) Introduced for the process of e-tendering which can be accessed on <https://indiaseeds.eproc.in>.

(1). **ACCESSING / PURCHASING OF BID DOCUMENTS:**

It is mandatory for all the bidders to have Class-III Digital Signature Certificate (With Both DSC Components, i.e. Signing & Encryption) from any of the licensed Certifying Agency (Bidders can see the list of licensed CA’s from the link www.cca.gov.in) to participate in e-tendering of NSCL.

C1-IndiaPvt.Ltd. facilitates for procurement of Class-III DSC’s. DSC Procurement request may be sent to jatin.kalra@c1india.com for more details during NSCL working days.

To participate in the e-bid, it is mandatory for the Applicants to get themselves registered with the NSCL e-Tendering Portal (<https://indiaseeds.eproc.in>), to have a User ID & Password which has to be obtained by submitting a non-refundable annual registration charges of Rs.3416/- inclusive of all taxes in favour of M/s C1 India Private Limited through Online mode. Validity of Registration is ONE Year. After making the payment through online mode (i.e. Net banking, Debit card, Credit Card), Vendors have to send an e-mail intimation nsclsupport@c1india.com to Helpdesk for their profile activation. The account will be activated within 24 working Hours. All profile activations will be done only during NSCL working days. No profile activation will take place during NSCL Holidays & Gazette holidays.

To participate in bidding, bidders have to pay Tender Processing Fee of Rs.570/- inclusive of all taxes (Non-refundable) through online mode (Internet banking/Debit card/Credit card).

To participate in bidding, bidders have to pay Tender Document (Non-Refundable) and EMD (Refundable) as per the amount mentioned in the tender document through Online from <https://indiaseeds.eproc.in>.

Both 'EMD' and 'Tender Document Fee' are mentioned in individual tender document as published at NSCL e-Tendering Portal (<https://indiaseeds.eproc.in>). The bidders who are MSE and registered with NSIC are exempted from paying EMD and tender document cost, for which they have to submit the documentary proof.

(2). PREPARATION SUBMISSION OF APPLICATION

Detailed NIT may be downloaded from NSCL e-tendering portal and the Application may be submitted compulsorily online mode following the instructions appearing on the screen /NIT.

Tenderer / Bidder can pay tender document Fee as per tender document online through Internet Banking/ Debit Card/Credit Card.

A Tenderer / Bidder manual containing the detailed guidelines for e-tendering system is also available on the portal.

(3). MODIFICATION/SUBSTITUTION/WITHDRAWAL OF BIDS:

The Bidder may modify, substitute or withdraw its e-bid after submission prior to the Bid Due Date. No Bid shall be modified, substituted or withdrawn by the Bidder on or after the Bid Due Date.

Any alteration / modification in the Bid or additional information supplied subsequent to the Bid Due Date, unless the same has been expressly sought for by the NSCL, shall be disregarded.

For modification of e-bid, bidder has to decrypt its old bid from e-tendering portal and upload / resubmit digitally signed modified bid.

For withdrawal of bid, bidder has to click on withdrawal icon at e-tendering portal and can withdraw its e-bid.

(4). OPENING AND EVALUATION OF APPLICATIONS

Opening of Applications will be done through online process. However, Corporation reserves the right for evaluation and decision based on tender submitted online. NSCL shall open documents of the Application received in electronic form of the tender on the Application due date i.e., in the presence of the Applicants who choose to attend. NSCL will subsequently examine and evaluate the Applications in accordance with the provisions set out in the Tender Document. The price bid will be opened of the responsive applicants. The date of opening of price bid will be notified later on.

(5). DISCLAIMER:

The vender must read all the instruction in the RFP and submit the same accordingly.

INSTRUCTIONS TO THE TENDERES / BIDDER

ADVISE FOR BIDDERS:

The Bidders are advised in their own interest to carefully read the tender documents and understand their purport unless the Bidder specifically states to the contrary in respect of any particular clause, it shall be presumed that they accept all the terms and conditions as have been laid down in tender document.

Tender Fee(Non-Refundable): Tender fee Rs.500/- (Rupees Two Hundred only) must be deposited (As per instruction in Section-I).

Earnest Money Deposit (Refundable): EMD amount Rs. 25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand only) must be deposited (As per instruction in Section-I). Exemption of EMD for Indian Manufactures which are registered with NSIC under Single point registration scheme, Indian manufactures / suppliers who are Micro and Small Enterprises (MSE) small scale units and registered with National Small Industries Corporation (NSIC) under single point registration scheme are exempted from payment of EMD provided to furnish photocopy of valid registration with NSIC under the single point registration scheme for the quoted stores in support if claim along with their requested letter. This facility will, however, not be provided to those small-scale units who are registered under the old registration scheme which was extended up to 30th June 1981 only. (Registration certificate to be attached.)

Eligibility Criteria: as per technical bid stated in “**Annexure-A**”.

Submission of Offer: Offer must be submitted in prescribed tender input form. Only that party should tender who accepts all the terms & conditions because conditional tender may be treated as void.

BID OPENING AND EVALUATION: Bids will be open in Online/ offline Mode (As per instruction in Section-I).

AWARD OF CONTRACT: The technical bid will open first and based on the purchase/sale committee will scrutinize the bid submitted and evolve the successful bidder for financial bid. Purchase/sale committee will award the Contract to the successful Bidder whose bid has been determined to be substantially responsive and has been determined as the best evaluated bid provided further that the Bidder is determined to be qualified to perform the Contract satisfactorily, for which the Firm may be asked for making a presentation, along with other parameters.

Notification of award: Prior to the expiration of the period of bid validity Selection Committee will place a firm order or notify the successful Bidder in writing.

Cancellation of Work order: NSC reserves the right to cancel the contract at any stage (by giving the notice in writing) due to non-satisfactory services of the selected firm.

Terms & Conditions for supply of 120MT Molasses at Central State Farm, Jawalgera

1. Supply of 120 MT Molasses on FOR destination basis.
2. Tender Fees of Rs.500/- (Five Hundred Only) and tender EMD of Rs.25,000/- (Twenty Five Thousand Only) will be payable by online mode only.
3. The amount of Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) will be converted into security deposit of the successful tenderer and for other it will be refunded without interest.
4. The Tenderer have no rights to modify the rates or return back once the tender submitted.
5. The tender will be limited and the material has to be supplied within 15 days from the date of Supply Order.
6. The Successful tenderer will have to deposit 10% amount of tendered amount as security deposits within 15 days which will be returned back after successfully completion of tender.
7. The Successful tenderer will not have any rights to transfer his contract to any other contractor.
8. Conditional Tender submitted by the tenderer will not be accepted.
9. Any of the tender or fax/letter/e-mail will not be accepted after opening of the tender.
10. The contractor will be responsible for supply of Molasses FOR destination including all taxes.
11. The Contractor has to unload the material in Molasses Tank in presence of NSC representative. The contractor will not have any rights to involve directly or indirectly into the work/activities which are not related to tender such as fire/ Animal Husbandry/ any construction work at the farm/ utilization of farm for keeping vehicles or machineries and other kind of work which makes roadblocks of farm work, etc. Any losses due to above activities will be recovered from him including forfeiting of his amount & rejection of contract.
12. If any kind of tax/permit, etc. is applicable for transportation will be borne by the contractor only.

13. The contractor has no rights to claim any subsidy or loss during transportation of molasses.
14. Losses, if any/damage in farm premises caused by the contractor or his personals will be recoverable from the contractor including termination of his contract.
15. The contractor or his personal will be prohibited from preying/hunting of wild life in the farm. If they do so, they will be held responsible and the offence will be punishable as per existing rule of law.
16. If the contractor found violating any terms & condition, farm has every right to cancel his contract and forfeit his EMD or security deposits.
17. Tenderer will have to deposit photocopy of his Voter ID/Ration Card and PAN Card/Address Proof. If any letter or information not reaches to the contractor due to incorrect or incomplete address, the farm will not be responsible.
18. The Competent Authority has rights to reject/cancel the whole/part of tender/auction without assigning any reason thereof.
19. If the contractor's behavior is not found satisfactory and found not abiding the terms & condition of the tender after repeated warning, Farm has rights to cancel his tender or contract as per terms & condition no. 16 of the contract and also blacklisted him for a period so that he will be disqualified for participating any tender/auction of the corporation.
20. An agreement agreeing the above terms & conditions duly signed by contractor with two witnesses on stamp paper of Rs. 100/- may be submitted immediately before issuing the work order.
21. If any dispute/difference/disagreement arise between the parties and unable to settle mutually may be referred to the sole arbitration to the Chairman Cum Managing Director of National Seeds Corporation Limited or other person appointed by the CMD, as arbitrator and their decision will be final which will be acceptable by both parties. However, in case of legal aid, New Delhi court is only the jurisdiction.

Arbitration:

The terms and condition have been announced/readout before the auction and/or told to me in my local language.
