It is mandatory for all the bidders to have Class-III Digital Signature Certificate (With Both DSC Components, i.e. Signing & Encryption) from any of the licensed Certifying Agency (Bidders can see the list of licensed CA’s from the link [www.cca.gov.in](http://www.cca.gov.in)) to participate in e-tendering of NSCL.

National Seeds Corporation Limited (NSC) requires fresh, good quality, processed different crop/varieties of Certified /Truthfully Labelled Seeds of Soyabean, Green Gram and Groundnut on consignment supply basis for supply to Karnataka State Department of Agriculture (KSDA) /Other Government Departments for distribution during Kharif-2021.

Each EOI Supplier has to submit bid in two bid system.

**Procedure for submission of EOI (online):**

1. **TECHNICAL BID:**

The TECHNICAL BID shall be submitted as per PART A, this contains the details of organisation, company profile, details of experience, EMD etc.

2. **FINANCIAL BID**

Each Supplier has to quote financial offers on per quintal basis as per PART B in e-portal.

**GENERAL TERMS & CONDITIONS OF TENDER**

1. Rate shall be quoted in Rs. Per Qtl **FOR Karnataka on consignment basis** for the fresh, net final cleaned/graded, tested and packed quantity (exclusive of bag weight) including NSC service margin of 5% . **The rate shall be all inclusive of packing material** and taxes etc., if any. Packing Material design will be given by NSC. The packing size are detailed below:

2. The Suppliers shall supply the seeds offered by them under this e-procurement EOI to the Karnataka State Department of Agriculture (KSDA) requirement/other Departments during Kharif-2021, for distribution under subsidy or any other programmes and shall agree to supply the seeds at the rates finalised by the rate fixation committee of KSDA or other Department for Kharif-2021.
3. Service Margin: The Service margin of 5 % of total Value is to be payable to NSC for the quantities sold by NSC.
4. The EOI shall be accompanied by interest free EMD of Rs. 200000.00/- through NEFT/RTGS after generating E-Challan from <https://indiaseeds.eproc.in>. Suppliers without EMD may be rejected. EMD of unsuccessful Supplier except the lowest three will be returned through RTGS after finalisation of rates by the Department (KSDA). EMD of the lowest three will be returned



after the entire deal is over. Outstanding amount, if any, of the supplier with NSC will not be considered for the EMD purpose. Only MSME's with NSIC certificate are exempted for payment of EOI document Fee and EMD subject to valid documentary proof of registration with NSIC.

5. EOI Supplier may upload their bid up to 3.00 PM. on **11.02.2021** and technical bids will be opened on the same date and place at 3.30 PM. in the presence of those suppliers who may wish to be present. **The hard copies of technical bid have to be submitted on or before 11.02.2021 at 3.00 pm.** Financial Bids will be opened for those whose Technical Bid will be in order as per NIT. Tenders received after the due date and time may be rejected.
6. The Supplier's offer shall be **valid up to 31<sup>st</sup> October 2021.** The quantity offered should be for at least 10 % of total required quantity in quintals. Delivery of the entire quantity offered by the Supplier and agreed by NSC should be as per supply schedule.
7. Failure to delivery 90% of the quantity approved by NSC shall entitle NSC to impose penalty @ 10% of the value of the shortfall in the supply at the rate agreed to. For delayed supplies penalty of Rs. 2/- per day per Qtl. will be charged.
8. The successful supplier shall remit interest free Security Deposit @ 3 % of the total value of the supply at the approved rate. This deposit shall be, remitted within five working days from the date of receiving the NSC's purchase order / intimation. EMD of the successful supplier can be adjusted in the security deposit. Failure to remit the Security Deposit, the same will be deducted from your first bill as Security deposit and will be released only after completion of total transactions.
9. The successful supplier shall at his cost execute an Agreement with NSC on Rs200/- non-judicial stamp paper of required value for arranging the supply as per the Terms and Conditions, sign each page of the Terms & Conditions and submit the same to NSC along with the Security Deposit.
10. If L 1 party offered less than the required quantity by corporation, the Corporation will take from other parties at L 1 rate to fulfil the total requirement.
11. Seeds to be treated with seed treatment chemical like Captan 75 dust / Thiram 75 WDP/ Captafol. If seeds are not treated at the time of packing, a packet containing sufficient quantity of chemical as per the recommended dose shall be kept inside each of the seed packet to enable the farmers to treat the seeds before sowing. A pamphlet in Kannada giving warning about chemical and the procedure to treat the seed should be kept inside the seed pocket along with sachet. In case of Soybean seeds polymer coating is compulsory for 25% of the total seeds offered by the supplier.
12. The seed shall be fresh, processed and packed as per NSC's requirement at the supplier's premises at his cost and expense. NSC shall have the right to inspect the operations from time to time.



13. The supplier and NSC will jointly arrange for the SCA's permission for packing the offered/accepted quantity in NSC bags.
14. a) **Truthfully labelled (TL) seeds:** The supplier shall make available to NSC a copy of the test reports from the notified seed testing lab regarding germination and other specified standards as per Seed Act for each lot before delivery to NSC.  
b) **Certified Seeds:** The supplier shall make available to NSC a copy of Release orders (FORM II) and Area Registration certificate issued by State Seed Certification Agency. **However priority for procurement will be given for certified seeds.**
15. NSC will draw representative samples of the final cleaned / graded seed lots offered by the supplier and have then analysed in NSC's Quality Control Laboratory (QCL) or any other laboratory identified by NSC. **Only the lot cleared both in state approved lab and NSC QCL lab will be finally accepted by NSC for procurement of Certified & TL seeds.**
16. The supplier will arrange the packing material, labels and certification tags, thread, lead seal at this own cost and will arrange for packing, i.e. Seed treatment, weighment, labelling & tagging, sealing, stacking etc shall have to bear at his cost under the supervision of NSC official. *A leaflet indicating package of practices in Kannada to be placed in the seed packet.*
17. The seed stock shall confirm to the quality and quantity specifications prescribed in the Minimum Seed Certification Standards 2013, as amended from time to time and shall possess good physical appearance, free from ODV, insect infestation and lustre to NSC's satisfaction.
18. The Seed is to be supplied in time as per the order of NSC; if any delay the seeds will not be accepted.
19. Supplier's failure to arrange the supply as per the terms & conditions will entitle NSC to cancel the order and arrange from the next party in the tender at the cost and risk of the defaulting supplier.
20. NSC may increase / decrease the final requirement from the quantity mentioned in the EOI. If required, NSC may repeat the order for the additional quantity within two months from the date of Security Deposit remittance. Beyond 25%, the increase will be with the consent of the supplier. NSC does not guarantee 100% lifting of offered quantity.
21. 75% payment will be released to Supplier after the receipt of bills along with acknowledgment from the Consignee (KSDA/Other Department /NSC Dealer) through RTGS within 30 days after deducting NSC service margin (5%), subject to receipt of farmer share from RSKs/ Department.
22. NSC will retain 25% payment along with Security Deposit as retention money for 180 days.
23. The Supplier shall, at his cost, take back part or full quantity of such stock proved defective on receipt by / delivery to NSC or unsold quantity. In the event of any dispute / complaint with reference to the seed quality, if the responsibility of the supplier is proved / established, he shall bear the loss / damage, if any sustained by NSC to relevant extent.



24. The supplier shall indemnify the NSC, KSDA, other Departments and the farmers from all the quality problems arising out of the seed supplied by the suppliers.
25. Conditional offers shall not be accepted and the Tenderer shall not impose any additional terms / conditions.
26. NSC reserves the right to accept / reject any or all the tenders without assigning any reason whatsoever. NSC further reserves the right to award the EOI to more than one Supplier. After analysing the rates offered by tenderer the same will be negotiated if required. NSC has the right to modify / delete / add any terms & conditions of tender supply as well as agreement to be executed after awarding of quantities to the Supplier.
27. **FORCE MAJEURE CLAUSE:** Notwithstanding the provisions of GCC clauses, the EOI shall not be liable for termination for default, if and to the extent that, its delay in performance or failure to perform its obligations under the contract is the result of an event of force majeure. as notified by the Government. For purposes of this clause, “**Force majeure**” means, an event beyond the control of the service provider and not involving the EOI provide a fault or negligence and not feasible. Such events may include, but are not limited to, acts of the procurement entity either in its sovereign or contractual capacity, wars or revolutions, fires, floods epidemics, quarantine restrictions and freight embargoes. If a force majeure situation arises, the supplier shall promptly notify the procurement entity in writing of such conditions and the cause thereof, unless otherwise directed by the procurement entity in writing, the Service provider shall seek all reasonable alternative means for performance not prevented by the force majeure event.
28. In case of any dispute arises between NSC and other party due to any term or matter, both the parties will opt to resolve it through mutual understanding and discussion. In case, disputes remains even after discussions, then it shall be binding upon parties to resolve issue under the provisions of Arbitration and conciliation Act, 1996 as amended from time to time. Under this provision, the Chairman-cum-Managing Director, National Seeds Corporation Limited with the concurrence of both the parties shall appoint Sole Arbitrator to resolve the issue and both the parties will have to abide by the decision. The parties will bind to resolve this dispute through arbitration before going to court of law. The Arbitration shall be conducted at New Delhi and shall be in English Language. The court of Delhi shall have the jurisdiction.

#### **OTHER TERMS & CONDITIONS.**

1. NSC shall not be responsible for fluctuation of the market rate of the ordered seed. The Tenderer shall be required to supply the seed at agreed rate only. The agreement can be terminated at any time due to non-performance of any of the terms & conditions of the agreement to the satisfaction of the Corporation.
2. The Supplier shall be responsible for State Sales Tax/Central Sales Tax/VAT and Income-tax liabilities, if any. NSC will not carry any tax liability related with the transaction.



3. NSC will not be responsible for the losses incurred to the supplier due to change in Govt. decisions, natural calamities, which are beyond the control of NSC.
4. Quality Control Inspectors of the concerned State may draw the samples of stocks. In case the stocks failed in seed testing the supplier will be responsible for the consequence of violation of Seed Act and Seed Laws. And in such cases the payment of that quantity will not be released to the party till NSC receives the same.
5. The weight of the seed container shall be checked at any point of transaction and in case shortage found in the container, NSC will not pay any cost against such supplies and the supplier shall be responsible for the legal consequence of Weights & Measures Department, if any.
6. The supplier will have to give the name of the firm, name of the processing plant, godown their postal addresses, telephone Nos. E-mail, name of the responsible person in the tender form itself so as to make further communication.
