SHORT TERM TENDER NOTICE

Short term Sealed offline and online tenders are invited from interested persons/parties **for sale of fodder jowar straw** (1673 acres approx.) and Bhusa (2250 quintals approx.) sown in Kharif 2024-25 at Central State Farm, Raichur till 01:00 PM on 20.03.2025, which will be opened on the same day (date 20.03.2025) at 03:00 PM. Interested eligible persons/firms are invited to participate in the tender. Before submitting the tenders, participants has to deposit tender **form fee of Rs. 236/- and EMD amount of Rs. 10,000/- only per each chak** through NEFT/RTGS and other online means. Detailed information for the tender, tender form and terms and conditions of work can be seen on the website www.indiaseeds.com. The successful tenderer will have to deposit 100 percent amount immediately after receipt of acceptance letter.

Terms and conditions:

1. To participate in the tender, tender fee of Rs. 236/- and EMD of Rs. 10,000/- only has to be deposited for each chak. If a person wishes to quote rates for more than one chak, then the entire EMD (Rs. 10,000 X the number of chaks for which rates are to be quoted in the tender) has to be deposited in one time through NEFT/RTGS/other online mode, only then the tender forms will be valid.
2. The earnest money deposited by the unsuccessful tenderers will be returned to them without any interest and the security money of the successful tenderers (Rs. 10,000/- per chak) will be returned without interest on satisfactory completion of the work. The earnest money deposited by the successful tenderers will be adjusted towards the security amount.
3. Tenderers are required to provide the copy of Aadhar Card, PAN Card and Bank Passbook having IFSC Code as proof of their permanent address along with the tender.
4. Before starting the work, the tenderer will have to deposit the entire amount of the approved area and will have to buy a stamp paper of Rs. 500/- at his own expense, describing all the terms and conditions and submit it to this office with the signature stating that he accepts all the conditions and will work according to them.
5. The tender amount, security amount and the amount in lieu of the area taken for straw by the successful tenderer must be deposited in the farm account only through RTGS/NEFT or other online medium. The details of the farm account are as follows:-

6. The entire amount should deposited immediately issue of the acceptance order. If a contractor does not deposit the entire amount or leaves the work before/in the middle, his deposit of security deposit will be forfeited.
7. The Farm Head will have the sole authority to accept/reject the rate/rates offered by the tenderer.
8. The tenderer will have to make arrangements for his tractor-trolley/Jeep/Truck etc for transportation.
9. The work has to be done as per the instructions of the Chak In-charge and Unit In-charge. The allotted area of the crop can be increased/decreased as per the requirement.
10. The work has to be done from 08:00 am to 06:00 pm. If due to any reason the work has to be delayed then the contractor has to inform the concerned Chak Incharge/Section Incharge/Head Guard.

11. The time for lifting the Jowar straw will be up to 15 days after issue of acceptance letter. In special circumstances, the time for lifting the Jowar straw can be extended by 07 days with the permission of the farm head. Even after that, if the contractor is unable to complete the work, then the farm will have the right to dispose of the fodder straw of allotted area at its own level and prepare the field for sowing Kharif crops and the contractor himself will be responsible for any loss of stubble in this.
12. The contractor will be solely responsible for making payments to the workers employed by him during the work; the firm will not be responsible for this at all.
15. The incomplete work which is left midway by the tenderer will be got done by another interested party after the stipulated time period (as per terms and condition no. 10) and in respect of this the tenderer who has left the work will not be paid any refund of the amount deposited by him and the security amount will also be forfeited.
16. Any taxes or duties, if applicable for the work, will be borne by the contractor. The firm will not be responsible for payment of any applicable taxes or duties.
17. The contractor taking the fodder straw will be fully responsible for the area taken by him. If the stubble is damaged due to natural calamity/rain, the farm will not be responsible.
18. If any accident occurs while making or transporting the fodder straw, the contractor will be completely responsible for it.
19. If any officer/employee of the farm is mistreated by the tenderer or his labour, in such a situation the decision of the farm head will be final.
20. All types of statutory liabilities will be of the contractor.
21. If the tenderer violates the terms and conditions of the tender or damages the farm produce/trees or other farm property, the work of the tenderer will be stopped with immediate effect. After inspection by the farm, if it is found that the damage to the farm is due to the fault of the tenderer or his labour, the security amount of the tenderer will be forfeited and the farm can impose a penalty and put him in the blacklist as per the severity of the mistake/damage caused.
22. If any dispute arises between NSC and the other party on account of any of the terms and conditions, both the parties shall opt to resolve the same through mutual understanding and discussion. If the dispute persists even after discussion, it shall be binding on the parties to resolve the issues under the provisions of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996, as amended from time to time. Under this provision, the Chairman-cum-Managing-Director of National Seeds Corporation Limited with the consent of both the parties shall appoint a sole arbitrator to resolve the issue and both the parties shall have to abide by the award. The parties shall resolve the dispute through arbitration before going to the court of law. The arbitration shall be conducted in New Delhi and in English language. The jurisdiction shall be of the Court of Delhi.
